

# Study Skills

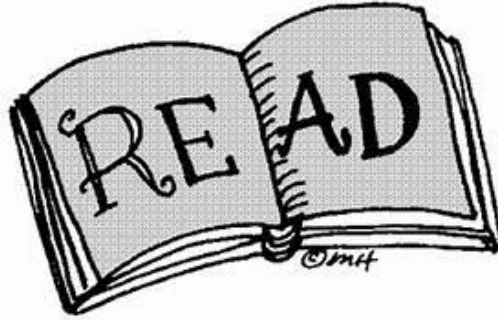


Library / Study Skills offers our Primary Grade students valuable opportunities for reading and story time. Reading aloud to your child is an excellent way to teach reading skills, so our younger students are encouraged to kick back, relax, and listen to a good story while the teacher assesses comprehension and learning. Students in 3rd grade will also be taught some fundamentals of studying and test-taking strategies.



Study Skills provides our students in 4th through 8th grade with the opportunity to learn study skills, test-taking strategies, research techniques, and writing skills. The test for this course is called *Simple Solutions - Study Skills*. The Common Core standards are the backbone for this excellent instructional text. Students in these grades will have an assignment to complete for each class. These assignments **MUST** be completed to obtain a passing grade for the quarter.

To be prepared for class in 4th-8th grade, students must bring their *Simple Solutions - Study Skills* test, a silent reading book, and pencil case each week. **ANY WORK NOT COMPLETED DURING CLASS WILL BE ASSIGNED AS HOMEWORK, DUE FOR THE NEXT CLASS.**



Students may borrow library books from their Homeroom teachers. Independent reading is encouraged after all text work is complete. We ask that books are treated with care and respect while out of our library. Please return the books by the due date so that others may enjoy them too.

Grading for this course will be PASS (S) or FAIL (I or U). An I or U in any class will keep a student off the Honor Roll in the Junior High grades.
