Subjects are aligned with the Common Core Standards. In addition to our classes, your child will have specials as part of the curriculum.

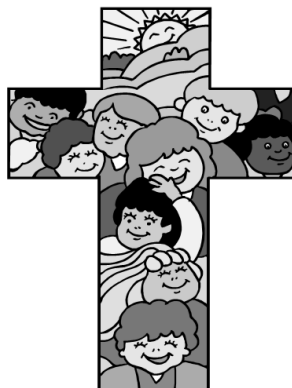
Classes:

Student grades are determined by tests, quizzes, classwork, homework, projects and class participation. Graded work will be posted on RenWeb and sent home in their Signing Folder. Please review, sign and return their signing folder the next day.





Homework

Homework will be assigned mainly Monday through Thursday. All homework assignments will be written daily in your child's Homework Tablet. Please review the assignments, complete it, sign homework tablet and return to school daily. Students will copy their own homework from the Smartboard. All assignments are due the next day unless otherwise noted. Homework assignments and weekly tests will also be posted on RenWeb or sent via Remind.

Daily homework will include but is not limited to reading weekly story, studying vocabulary and spelling words.

If your child is absent, please notify the office and make arrangements to pick up their work. Please know that work will not be given ahead of time for students going on vacation.

Testing/Quizzes

Students will be given chapter and/or unit test. Test dates will be announced via the students Homework Tablet, Remind, Weekly Summary Note and RenWeb.

Quizzes may be announced or unannounced. At this age, a workbook page may be collected and graded to check student's understanding of the concepts.

Homework/classwork may also be used as a quiz grade.

Folders

Daily Folder: Please check it nightly and remove all items in the *Left at Home* (left side) side of the folder. Items/assignments in the *Return to School* side should be reviewed/completed and put back into the *Return to School* (right side) of the folder. The Daily Folder must be returned each day.

Signing Folder: Will contain graded assignments and sent home weekly. Please review, sign pages and return the following day. Please do not remove papers from the folder.

Communication

Communication between parents/guardians and the teacher is very important to the education process. To make communication more accessible, please add your email address to RenWeb and sign up for Remind (directions attached).

If you would like to meet with me, please send in a note to make an appointment.

Parent Notifications

A note will be sent home via the Daily Folder if your child exhibits behavior issues, misses homework or classwork. Please sign and return the following day. Remind may also be used. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact me.

Birthdays

If you would like your child to celebrate his/her special day at school, you may send in one treat for the class. Please be aware of any classroom allergies. There are 20 students (14 girls & 6 boys). Students wishing to pass out invitations for after school parties may do so **ONLY** if the entire class (or every girl or every boy) is included.

Snack & Lunch

Students will enjoy snack each morning. Please pack *one healthy* snack and drink for your child. We will have snack on regular and early dismissal days. We will not have snack on late arrivals days (due to weather).

Lunch: please return weekly menu and payment by Friday

Lunch snack prices: 25 cents to \$1- please put money in their new change purse

Money and Other Items

When sending in money, please send it in an envelope labeled with your child's name, purpose (lunch, snack, field trip, etc.), amount enclosed. This way proper credit will be give!

When sending in notes, please include your child's name and date. Please label all of your child's supplies, backpacks, gym sweatshirts, etc.
