## INDUCTION CRITERIA

### SCHOLARSHIP: The student who demonstrates scholarship has:

- ❖ 92.5% G.P.A.
- ❖ Once inducted into the NJHS students must maintain the required 92.5% GPA. Failure to do so will result in the student being placed on academic probation until the next marking period. If the student's GPA does not meet the standard for a second time, he/she will be dismissed from the NJHS and will not be eligible for membership again.

### LEADERSHIP: The student who exercises leadership:

- Demonstrates leadership in promoting school activities.
- Active membership in at least one of the LaSalle group or sport organizations listed below:

- Exercises influence on peers in upholding school ideals.

**SERVICE: The student who serves:**

**Completes 20 hours of school/church/community service**

- Participates in some out of school activity; Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, church groups, volunteer organizations.
- Is gladly available and offers assistance.
- Is willing to make sacrifices for render service.
- Cheerfully and enthusiastically renders service to the school.
- Works well with others and is willing to take on responsibility.
- Shows courtesy by assisting and greeting visitors, teachers, and other students.

**CHARACTER: The student with character:**

**Character is an integral component of the NJHS. Students who earn ONE detention will be placed on disciplinary probation, and a SECOND detention will result in dismissal from the NJHS.**

- Consistently exemplifies desirable qualities of behavior.
- Takes criticism willingly and accepts recommendations graciously.
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability.
- Shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others and their property.
- Avoids cheating in written work.
- Observes rules concerning punctuality, responsibility, and truthfulness.
- No excessive absenteeism/tardiness

**CITIZENSHIP: The student who demonstrates citizenship:**

- Has high regard for freedom, justice, and respect for fellow human beings.
